Subject: Wide Opposition in Maine to Ex-Coal Lobbyist Confirmation to Run Environmental Protection Agency

Date: February 4, 2019

A new Public Policy Polling survey of Maine voters finds wide opposition to the confirmation of ex-coal lobbyist Andrew Wheeler to run the Environmental Protection Agency.

Only 26 percent of voters think Wheeler should be confirmed, with 52 percent opposing Wheeler.

PPP surveyed 814 Maine voters from January 31-February 3, 2019. The margin of error is +/- 3.4%. This poll was conducted by automated telephone and online interviews on behalf of EDF Action.
