Subject: Preservation of Conservation Funding a Top Priority for Farm Bill in

California's 24th Congressional District

Date: November 3, 2023

A new Public Policy Polling survey finds that preserving conservation funding is California 24th Congressional District voters' top priority for this year's Farm Bill. A third of voters (32%) think preserving conservation funding for all farmers should be Rep. Salud Carbajal's top priority, rather than increasing funding for the federal crop insurance program (6%) or increasing government subsidies for certain commodities (8%).

Nearly half of voters (49%) are opposed to cutting funding for USDA conservation programs, compared to just 20% who support it. Voting to cut conservation funding would also be detrimental to Rep. Carbajal's re-election efforts, with 42% of voters saying they would be less likely to vote for him should he support a Farm Bill that cuts these programs. Just 8% say they would be more likely to.

Just under a quarter of CA-24 voters (22%) say they are following news about the Farm Bill at least somewhat closely, and 16% say they or an immediate family member work in farming or the agricultural industry. These voters are in most cases at least as likely if not even more likely to support conservation funding in the Farm Bill than the overall electorate, and they are likely to vote accordingly in the next election.

- 30% of voters who follow the Farm Bill news very closely and 47% who have been following it somewhat closely say preserving conservation funding should be the top priority, rather than increasing subsidies for certain commodities (8% for those following the bill very closely and 8% for those following somewhat closely) or increasing funding for the federal crop insurance program (14% for those following the bill very closely and 10% for those following it somewhat closely).
- 48% of voters following the bill very closely and 59% following it somewhat closely oppose cutting funding for USDA conservation programs.






• 42% of voters who work in farming or the agriculture industry, or have immediate family working in the industry, say preserving conservation funding should be Rep. Carbajal's top priority in the Farm Bill.

Before being asked about conservation programs, 19% of voters expressed general support for reauthorizing the Farm Bill, to 9% opposed and 73% having no opinion. Supporters are the most adamant that conservation programs be spared any cuts, with 53% labeling those programs their top priority, 65% opposing cuts, and 52% saying a vote for a Farm Bill with slashed conservation funding would make them less likely to support Carbajal's reelection, while only 11% would be more likely.

Public Policy Polling surveyed 611 voters from California's 24th Congressional District from October 27-28, 2023. The margin of error is +/- 4.0%. 64% of interviews for the survey were conducted by text message and 36% by telephone.
