Subject: Preservation of Conservation Funding a Top Priority for Farm Bill in Colorado's 8th Congressional District

Date: September 26, 2023

A new Public Policy Polling survey finds that preserving conservation funding is Colorado 8th Congressional District voters' top priority for this year's Farm Bill. A plurality of voters (35%) think preserving conservation funding for all farmers should be Rep. Yadira Caraveo's top priority, rather than increasing funding for the federal crop insurance program (10%) or increasing government subsidies for certain commodities (7%).

A majority of CO-08 voters (53%) are opposed to cutting funding for USDA conservation programs, compared to just 21% who support it. Voting to cut conservation funding would also be detrimental to Rep. Caraveo's re-election efforts, with nearly half (48%) saying they would be less likely to vote for her should she support a Farm Bill that cuts these programs. Just 4% say they would be more likely to.

More than a quarter of CO-08 voters (27%) say they are following news about the Farm Bill at least somewhat closely, and 18% say they or an immediate family member work in farming or the agricultural industry. These voters are even more likely to support conservation funding in the Farm Bill than the overall electorate, and they are likely to vote accordingly in the next election.

- 41% of voters who follow the Farm Bill news very closely and 41% who have been following it somewhat closely say preserving conservation funding should be the top priority, rather than increasing subsidies for certain commodities (26% for those following the bill very closely and 13% for those following somewhat closely) or increasing funding for the federal crop insurance program (9% for those following the bill very closely and 15% for those following it somewhat closely).
- 86% of voters following the bill very closely and 55% following it somewhat closely oppose cutting funding for USDA conservation programs.





- 37% of voters who work in farming or the agriculture industry, or have immediate family working in the industry, say preserving conservation funding should be Rep. Caraveo's top priority in the Farm Bill rather than increasing government subsidies for certain commodities (15%) and increasing funding for the federal crop insurance program (13%).
- 59% of voters working in agriculture oppose cutting funding for USDA conservation programs, while just 28% support it.
- 54% of voters working in agriculture say they are less likely to vote for Rep.
 Caraveo in the next election if she supports a Farm Bill that cuts conservation funding, while only 5% would be more likely to.

Before being asked about conservation programs, 28% of voters expressed general support for reauthorizing the Farm Bill, to 6% opposed and 66% having no opinion. Supporters are the most adamant that conservation programs be spared any cuts, with 46% labeling those programs their top priority, 67% opposing cuts, and 60% saying a vote for a Farm Bill with slashed conservation funding would make them less likely to support Caraveo's reelection.

Public Policy Polling surveyed 561 voters from Colorado's 8^{th} Congressional District from September 21-22, 2023. The margin of error is +/- 4.1%. 61% of interviews for the survey were conducted by text message and 39% by telephone.
