# Subject: Preservation of Conservation Funding a Top Priority for Farm Bill in North Carolina's 1<sup>st</sup> Congressional District

### Date: November 3, 2023

A new Public Policy Polling survey finds that preserving conservation funding is North Carolina 1<sup>st</sup> Congressional District voters' top priority for this year's Farm Bill. A plurality of voters (39%) think preserving conservation funding for all farmers should be Rep. Don Davis' top priority, rather than increasing funding for the federal crop insurance program (10%) or increasing government subsidies for certain commodities (8%).

A majority of voters (56%) are opposed to cutting funding for USDA conservation programs, compared to just 17% who support it. Voting to cut conservation funding would also be detrimental to Rep. Davis' re-election efforts, with more than half (55%) saying they would be less likely to vote for him should he support a Farm Bill that cuts these programs. Just 8% say they would be more likely to.

Just over a third of NC-01 voters (36%) say they are following news about the Farm Bill at least somewhat closely, and 23% say they or an immediate family member work in farming or the agricultural industry. These voters are at least as likely if not even more likely to support conservation funding in the Farm Bill than the overall electorate, and they are likely to vote accordingly in the next election.

- 57% of voters who follow the Farm Bill news very closely and 50% who have been following it somewhat closely say preserving conservation funding should be the top priority, rather than increasing subsidies for certain commodities (3% for those following the bill very closely and 10% for those following somewhat closely) or increasing funding for the federal crop insurance program (13% for those following the bill very closely and 12% for those following it somewhat closely).
- 54% of voters following the bill very closely and 61% following it somewhat closely oppose cutting funding for USDA conservation programs.





- 37% of voters who work in farming or the agriculture industry, or have immediate family working in the industry, say preserving conservation funding should be Rep. Davis' top priority in the Farm Bill.
- 59% of voters working in agriculture oppose cutting funding for USDA conservation programs, while just 18% support it.
- 57% of voters working in agriculture say they are less likely to vote for Rep. Davis in the next election if he supports a Farm Bill that cuts conservation funding, while only 5% would be more likely.

Before being asked about conservation programs, 28% of voters expressed general support for reauthorizing the Farm Bill, to 6% opposed and 66% having no opinion. Supporters are the most adamant that conservation programs be spared any cuts, with 51% labeling those programs their top priority, 64% opposing cuts, and 59% saying a vote for a Farm Bill with slashed conservation funding would make them less likely to support Davis' re-election, while only 9% would be more likely.

Public Policy Polling surveyed 602 voters from North Carolina's 1<sup>st</sup> Congressional District from October 27-28, 2023. The margin of error is +/- 3.9%. 50% of interviews for the survey were conducted by text message and 50% by telephone.
