RE: Results: Coronavirus Message Testing

Morning Consult conducted an online survey, on behalf of EDF Action, between April 3 – April 5, 2020 among a national sample of 1,990 registered voters. The data were weighted to approximate a target sample of registered voters based on age, race/ethnicity, gender, educational attainment, and region. Results from the full survey have a margin of error of \pm 2 percentage points.

The survey sought to measure the effectiveness of both oppositional and supportive messaging related to the inclusion of clean energy investments in the next coronavirus economic recovery package.

KEY FINDINGS

Initial Priority of Clean Energy in the Next Economic Recovery Package

Almost all voters say it is important that the government pass coronavirus economic recovery packages (91%), and half say it is a priority to include clean energy in the next package (55%). Including clean energy in the next package is especially a priority for Democrats (69%) and 2018 Democratic voters (66%). At the same time, half of Independents (51%), used as a proxy for swing voters, and '2012 Obama + 2016 Trump voters' (47%) also say it is a priority.

Most Convincing Supportive Messages

EDF Action tested various messages to determine the most effective messages for countering attacks by those who oppose including clean energy elements in the COVID-19 recovery bills being considered by Congress.

Overall, statements focusing on the Trump administration and a lack of proactivity in the face of threats, the impacts of ignoring warnings from scientists, and discouraging the use of coronavirus as an ideological agenda perform the strongest among voters generally. 2018 Democratic voters, also found messaging related to Trump administration and a lack of proactivity in the face of threats (57%) and the impacts of ignoring warnings from scientists (45%) *very* convincing. 
Effectiveness of Messages Overall

After learning more, two-thirds of voters say it is a priority to include clean energy in the next coronavirus economic recovery package, an 11-point increase after messaging. Increases in priority are also seen across key audience segments, speaking to the effectiveness of the supportive statements tested:

- 2018 Democratic voter: 82% (+16)
- Democrat: 84% (+15)

- Independent: 60% (+9)
- 2012 Obama + 2016 Trump voter: 65% (+18)
